He will discuss station idea generation, prompting question exploration, relevant background information inclusion, station revision to final acceptance. Dr. Trinh will discuss the type of stations to include or avoid. He will explore with the participants the creation of challenging prompting questions and inclusion of relevant background information for an MMI station. Finally, his experience with the last stage of station editing and acceptance of the MMI questions will also be discussed. Participants will go through an exercise of a station and question writing if time permits.
