Biography:

Professor Barbara Griffin is an endorsed organizational psychologist and currently Director of the Organisational Psychology program at Macquarie University. She has established a research program investigating person-environment fit and adjustment processes across the career cycle, including projects on selection, maladaptive behaviour, and career transition. Barbara led the team that developed the admissions process for a new medical school in western Sydney, initiating a major longitudinal study assessing its validity. More recently, she has collaborated on several multi-institutional projects on medical student selection. She publishes on selection interviews, the effects of commercial coaching, and the widening participation in medicine of those from low socio-economic backgrounds.
