

Biography

Dr. Junhui Bian graduated from the 8-year medical program at Peking Union Medical College in 1987 and worked as a researcher at Institute of Basic Medical Sciences, Chinese Academy of Medical Sciences. In 1988, he was admitted into the Ph.D program of University of Maryland School of Medicine on a full scholarship and was awarded the Ph.D degree in Biochemistry in 1993. Subsequently, he served as a postdoctoral fellow, assistant professor, associate professor and professor at Oklahoma Medical Research Foundation, Parke-Davis Pharmaceutical Research (A Warner-Lambert Company, now Pfizer), Abilene Christian University, and Shantou University Medical College respectively. His research interests included mechanisms of intracellular transport, the expression and regulation of tumor suppressor genes. He and his colleagues published these studies in Science, Journal of Biological Chemistry, PNAS, Carcinogenesis, Oncogenes, Cellular and Molecular Biology and others.

Dr. Bian served as the director of SUMC Center for Faculty Development (2009-2013) and the assistant dean (2010-2012). He was appointed as the executive dean at Shantou University Medical College in January of 2013.
